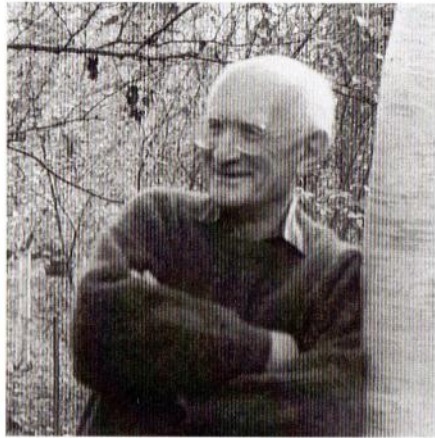

STONE LANE: A HISTORY

Over 40 years ago, Kenneth and June were married at Stone Farm. Kenneth immediately started planting trees, inspired by the site with its wide views across to Dartmoor. Kenneth had a passion for trees and became a modern-day plant hunter, travelling around the Northern Hemisphere in search of Birch and Alder species to grow here. Many of the spectacular trees that grace the garden today have been grown from his wild-collected seed. June, an artist, saw that the trees would make an inspirational setting for outdoor art, and so the annual Mythic Garden sculpture exhibition was born.

Today, June continues to run the exhibition at Stone Lane. Paul Bartlett, who worked with Kenneth for over ten years, manages the Garden and also the adjacent tree nursery that offers for sale an extensive range of Birches and Alders (discounts available for Friends).
