Stone Lane Gardens

Stone Lane Gardens was the creation of Kenneth and June Ashburner, the owners of Stone farm. Kenneth was an avid traveller and plant hunter and from the early 1970's began planting the trees he had grown from seed gathered on his travels and from other botanic gardens. Kenneth was an early exponent of naturalistic garden design. His understated style created a woodland garden that is peaceful and atmospheric.



In 1992 artist June created the first outdoor sculpture exhibition here. She invited local sculptors to display their imaginative work in the developing garden, to great effect. Exhibitions have been held here ever since.

In 1995, Plant Heritage awarded the garden 'National Collection' status in recognition of the importance of the diversity and rarity of its birch and alder trees.

In 2024, Stone Lane Gardens became an accredited Botanic Garden. An internationally recognised accreditation awarded by Botanic Gardens Conservation International.
